Wireless Network Access (MP 1000.39)

Purpose

To define access of the available wireless (WIFI) networks within proximity of the Nebraska Task Force 1 (NE-TF1) warehouse facility.

Policy

Several wireless (WIFI) networks have an available signal that is capable of transmitting data within broadcast range of the NE-TF1 warehouse facility. Under normal operating conditions, two are available for use by the staff and guests of NE-TF1: City County Public, and NE-TF1. These networks are maintained and owned by the City of Lincoln, NE Networking Department. If a disruption in service is encountered on either network, a member of the NE-TF1 administrative staff shall be alerted, to contact their designated representative, to ensure a restoration of service.

NE-TF1 WIFI Network

This network is secure, password locked, and only to be utilized by the electronic devices owned and maintained by NE-TF1. This is the preferred network of all NE-TF1 owned electronic devices while operating within its broadcast range. If a device is found unable to access to this network, a member of the NE-TF1 administrative staff shall be contacted for direction on how to proceed. Under no circumstances shall the network password be shared or entered in a device by anyone other than a member of the NE-TF1 administrative staff. If suspicion arises that the password has been shared or compromised, the designee of the Program Director shall be immediately contacted for direction, and initiation of the remediation process.

City County Public WIFI Network

This network is unsecured, requires no password, and can be utilized by WIFI capable devices belonging to anyone, including those owned and maintained by NE-TF1. This is the preferred network for the general public, the guests of NE-TF1, and anyone else who chooses to use their personally owned and maintained WIFI capable electronic devices within the facility.
