Purpose

To describe the application process to become a member of Nebraska Task Force 1 (NE-TF1)

Procedure

NE-TF1 opens its application process on an as needed basis, typically in the fall of each calendar year. All applicants must be a citizen of the United States of America (USA), possess a valid driver's license, and have no felony convictions. Applications are open to personnel from NE-TF1's sponsoring agency (SA), any other participating services agency, or civilians with a skill set unique to a specialty position. Application may be initiated through following steps:

1. Review the NE-TF1 recruitment announcement at the following link:

2. Review the position description relative to the position you are applying for.
3. Complete the application process at the following link:
<https://www.nebraskataskforce1.com/application-process>. Applications should be submitted online with all required documentation.

Considerations

- Applicants need not meet all position training requirements to apply for NE-TF1 membership.
- All relevant work experience, training, certifications, and professional licensures should be included in an attached resume.
- Verification of training, certifications, and licensures should be attached to the application.

Received Applications

- Determine if the application and résumé meet the minimum scope of knowledge guidelines. If so, include the applicant in a pool of eligible personnel.
- Upon review, subject matter experts (SMEs) shall select candidates who are the most qualified. This will be based on education, certification, and experience.
- An interview process may be conducted prior to acceptance to NE-TF1.
- The list of recommended qualified candidates will then be issued to the SA, or participating emergency services agency.

- Pending agency approval, accepted applicants will be notified and categorized at the recruit level.

Upon acceptance of an offer to join NE-TF1, the applicant shall:

- Submit to a health physical provided and scheduled by the task force.
- Agree to obtain all inoculations required for deployment.
- Be eligible to receive task force issued personal equipment. A full complement of task force issued gear may not be issued until the task force member meets all requirements for deployment.
- Participate in required training as scheduled to be eligible for deployment.
